
But the notion of *Haus* relates to other connotations than what we too simply define as a 'house'.

In this assignment we want to search for the ultimate experience of a staircase'house'.




The result is a step by step process through interventions and the ongoing division and elimination of redundancies, finally to be executed in a one material model on scale 1:33.
