Not a standard recording of reality, but for example a special view of a detail, a shadow, a worn staircase, a completely renovated floor, wrong restored window frame, the real canal green, in short, a visual story that gives a new insight in canal houses of the last 400 years in 400 minutes told. A study of 400 years of canal houses by means of 400 one minute movies about the tactile qualities of living, working and staying on canal houses from an architectural perception.
